The Authority has noted that the Masakhane Security Training Provider, one of the security training providers, has short-changed its students. This came to light when 300 of its learners were reported to have been trained in their respective Grades, but their course reports were not submitted to PSiRA for processing. Of the 300 course reports, the training center submitted one report.

According to the Director of Masakhane Security Training Provider, her financial issues are the main reason behind the non-submission of the course reports of the students. We have since charged and withdrew this company as it had acted unlawfully and against the PSiRA Code of Conduct.

As the Authority, we strongly caution students to verify that the training centres they are enrolled in submit their course reports to PSiRA through the online system within fourteen days.
