The Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSiRA) with its head office in Pretoria, Centurion is a statutory body established in terms of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No.56 of 2001) to regulate the private security industry in South Africa. PSiRA is looking for dynamic, experienced, and suitably qualified professionals to serve on its Audit and Risk Committee, which is a sub-committee of the PSiRA Council.

INVITATION TO SERVE ON PSiRA AUDIT AND RISK COMMITTEE

The Authority invites experienced and suitably qualified persons to serve on its Audit and Risk Committee. Applicants should ideally be qualified and competent in any of the following areas, with at least 10 years working experience:

- Auditing and Accounting up to the level of at least Chartered Accountant;
- Financial Management;
- Risk Management,
- Governance and Compliance;
- Information and Communication Technology (ICT)

Knowledge and experience of the following are essential, but not limited to the list:

- Exposure to internal audit legal frameworks, systems and processes;
- Risk management, governance and compliance systems and processes;
- Auditing and forensic investigations;
- Accounting and accounting standards and policies applicable to public entities;
- Corporate governance and compliance in the public sector;
- Supply Chain Management processes;
- Organisational Performance Management as it relates to public entities;
- Information Technology systems; and
- Serving on Audit Committees in the public sector

The Audit Committee is an oversight body which operates and fulfils its roles in terms of Regulation 27 of the Treasury Regulations promulgated under the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (PFMA). Qualification as a Chartered Accountant CA(SA) and registration with relevant regulatory/professional bodies would be an added advantage for persons to be considered for appointment as Chairperson of the Committee. Applicants must take note of the disqualifications for appointment as councillors as prescribed under section 7 of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No.56 of 2001) (copy available on our website: www.psiira.co.za).
