## **INDUSTRY CIRCULAR NO.09/2022**

## TO: ALL SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDERS

## FROM: OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR -PSiRA

SUBJECT: EXTENSION FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE INDUSTRY COMPLIANCE SELF-ASSESSMENT

- The primary objective of Authority is to regulate the Private Security Industry and to exercise effective control over the practice and the occupation of the security service providers in the public and national interest and in the interest of the private security industry.
- 2. As part of regulating the private security industry, the self-assessment was launched on the on the 30 May 2022, to afford security businesses the opportunity to assess themselves. The closing date for the submission of the self-assessments was scheduled for the 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2022.
- 3. In view of the private security industry being such a large industry and the objective being that all registered security businesses have an adequate opportunity to assess themselves, the due date for the submission of the self-assessments have been extended until the **31<sup>st</sup> of December 2022.**

- 4. The process has been simplified and security businesses will be required to assess themselves via an online platform. As this is a digital process, the assessment will be completed online, and no printed copies will be accepted at any of our offices.
- 5. Kindly adhere to the closing date regarding the return of the Industry Compliance Self-Assessments. The closing date for submission will therefore be extended to <u>31 December 2022</u>. No late submissions will be accepted.
- 6. Please note that the completion of the Self- Assessment is compulsory for all registered security businesses and any failure to do so may impact negatively on the services offered to the Industry by the Authority (Renewal of certificates; letters of good standing).
