4.	Presentation	 Mr. Moepi presented the Technical Specification as per the TOR and afforded the bidders the opportunity to ask questions. He further presented the evaluation criteria for funtionality as per the TOR. Ms. Mendu presented the mandatory returnable documents as well as mandatory requirements as per the tender checklist published.
5.	Discussion	Below are questions raised by the bidders and the answers provided.
	and Questions	Q1. Will the contract be for 18 months?
		Ans: No, It will be for 24 months.
		Q2. What kind of insurance do you want?
		Ans: Full user damage (comprehensive cover).
		Q3. Who is the current service provider?
		Ans. Vodacom.
		Q4. Do you want your accessories to be part of the contract or once off?
		Ans: It will depend bidders; bidders must indicate if it will be (MRC) monthly recurring costs or (NRC) non-recurring costs.
		Q5. Can you clarify the split billing account?
		Ans: PSiRA sponsor its users, In a case where the user has spent more than the amount allocated, he or she will have to pay.



Q6. What will happen if the user does not pay?

Ans: The service provider can block the phone, however the account might be cleared by PSiRA but the phone must remain blocked until the Authority request the service provider to unblock the phone. Non-payment will therefore be handled internally.

Q7. Are you looking for company footprint or dealer's footprint?

Ans: The dealer's footprint will suffice, we need to know that if users encounter problems they will have a store where they will take their phones for repairs.

Q8. In the event where the dealer cannot offer a loan phone, are we allowed to courier the phone?

Ans. Yes, you are allowed.

Q9. If Vodacom becomes the successful bidder, will you upgrade or require new lines?

Ans. The bidder will have to advise the Authority of that.

Q10. On your current contract how many days' notice do you have to give for termination of contract?

Ans. 30 days' notice.
