Dear Valuable Stakeholder,

As you might now be well aware, the Authority has met with leaders of a workers' formation that had intended to mobilise security officers to strike last month. We managed to talk them out of their initial intentions to embark on a protest that appeared to be volatile. This time around, PSiRA has been informed of a planned 'peaceful march' by the same formation, African Security Congress (ASC) or TUSISA (the party's labour representative union), which will culminate in a submission of a memorandum of demands to be handed to the Authority's Leadership in Germiston on **Monday, 27 November 2017, at 13:00.**

Whilst the leadership of ASC have assured us that the planned protest march will be incident-free and without violent disruptions, it would be prudent to make contingency plans for service providers whose employees might be part of this march.
